ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 60 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED "DOGS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lacey,
County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 60-1 of the Township Code of the Township of Lacey, entitled "Leashing and muzzling regulations," is hereby amended and supplemented to provide as follows:

§ 60-1. Owner responsible for control of dogs.

The owner of any dog or dogs in the Township of Lacey shall be responsible to control the dog or dogs in the manner provided herein.

- A. No dog shall be allowed to run at large on private property, other than the property of its owner or custodian, or on any of the public streets or public places of this Township, unless such dog is accompanied by a person who is capable of controlling it and the dog is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six (6) feet long.
- B. No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall permit such dog to soil, defile, defecate upon any sidewalk, street or upon any public property or in or upon the property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog. If a dog should defecate upon any sidewalk, street, public property or property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog, the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog shall be responsible for the removal of such defecation from such property and shall properly dispose of the same.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 60 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED "DOGS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 60-1 of the Township Code of the Township of Lacey, entitled "Leashing and muzzling regulations," is hereby amended and supplemented to provide as follows:

§ 60-1. Owner responsible for control of dogs.

The owner of any dog or dogs in the Township of Lacey shall be responsible to control the dog or dogs in the manner provided herein.

- A. No dog shall be allowed to run at large on private property, other than the property of its owner or custodian, or on any of the public streets or public places of this Township, unless such dog is accompanied by a person who is capable of controlling it and the dog is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six (6) feet long.
- B. No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall permit such dog to soil, defile, defecate upon any sidewalk, street or upon any public property or in or upon the property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog. If a dog should defecate upon any sidewalk, street, public property or property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog, the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog shall be responsible for the removal of such defecation from such property and shall deposit the same in a garbage can or receptacle.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
