## NJ "RUN FOR THE FALLEN" TO HONOR AND REMEMBER NEW JERSEY ARMY, NAVY, AIR FORCE, MARINES & COAST GUARD KILLED DURING THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERROR (GWOT)

Relay Team to Cover One Mile for Each NJ Fallen Service Member in Run from Cape May Lighthouse to NJ Vietnam Veterans' Memorial in Holmdel NJ.

**Holmdel, NJ** - In an apolitical reflection of remembrance a team of 28 military members from Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst and other locations across the US will come together to embark on a 190+ mile journey to honor every New Jersey service member killed in support of the Global War on Terror (GWOT). Each mile is dedicated to an individual NJ Hero and their family, and the run team will stop at each Hero Marker (each mile) to present a flag and personalized biographical card to waiting family members, friends, and comrades with the goal of creating a 190+ mile memorial trail through New Jersey.

"NJ Run for the Fallen" will kick off on Thursday September 21st at 8:00am at Cape May Lighthouse with a "start" ceremony for the four day, 190+ mile run through Wildwood, Stone Harbor/Avalon, Sea Isle City, Ocean City, Somers Point, Egg Harbor, Galloway, Tuckerton, Long Beach Island, Ocean Twp., Toms River, Brick, Mantoloking, Point Pleasant, Sea Girt, Belmar, Bradley Beach, Asbury Park, Long Branch, Oceanport, Shrewsbury and Lincroft to finish at the NJ Vietnam Veterans' Memorial in Holmdel on National Gold Star Mother/Family Day, Sunday September 24h, 2017.
